Make-A-Wish is looking for friendly and reliable volunteers who have great listening skills and experience of working with families and children. You'll be visiting children who have been referred and helping them to unlock their wildest imagination to discover their One True Wish.

Make-A-Wish aims to grant 1,000 wishes each year. It's a team effort - and we simply can't do it without you. We'd be asking you to commit to at least 3 visits a year, whilst ensuring that you kept yourself up to date with all relevant updates and training.



Reading Rooms is a Verbal Arts Centre Programme that uses a unique reading aloud and shared reading model to encourage participants to share their ideas, thoughts or memories and start conversations inspired by the short stories and poems read by facilitators, who are all trained volunteers.

The Children in Need project is currently recruiting volunteers to work with children and young people at risk or in care. The volunteers will be offered free OCN accredited training in Facilitation Skills for Shared Reading (Level2). There are also opportunities for monthly peer- support meetings and invitations to bi-annual celebrations and other special events as part of our volunteer support activities.
